We're thrilled to have them both with us and look forward to the contributions they'll make to our school community.

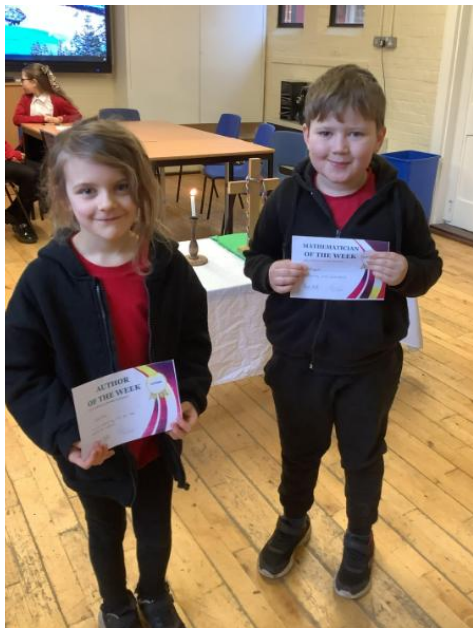
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Celebration Assembly
