This accessibility statement applies to the website of Cavendish Church of England Primary School.

Cavendish Church of England Primary School is committed to making its website accessible to as many people as possible, including people with disabilities and those who use assistive technologies.

We want visitors to be able to access the information they need as easily as possible.

Our website is provided through eSchools, and school staff are responsible for the content that we upload and maintain.

Using this website

We aim to make our website clear, simple and easy to navigate.

Technical information about this website's accessibility

Cavendish Church of England Primary School is committed to making its website accessible in accordance with the Public Sector Bodies (Websites and Mobile Applications) (No. 2) Accessibility Regulations 2018.

Primary and secondary schools are partially exempt from the accessibility regulations, except in relation to content that people need in order to use the school's services. We nevertheless aim to make the wider content on our website as accessible as reasonably possible.

Compliance status

The website is built and hosted using the eSchools platform.

We are currently reviewing the website's accessibility against the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 AA standard and working with our website provider to ensure that the technical platform and the content maintained by the school support accessibility.

We will update this statement when further accessibility testing or information from our website provider becomes available.

Non-accessible content

Documents and PDFs

Some PDF and Word documents published on the website may not be fully accessible to users of assistive technology. We will aim to ensure that new documents containing important information are produced in an accessible format wherever possible.

If you experience difficulty accessing a document, please contact the school office and we will provide the information in an alternative accessible format.

Content that is outside the scope of the accessibility regulations

The accessibility regulations do not require us to make PDFs or other documents published before 23 September 2018 accessible if they are not essential to providing our services.

Live video is also exempt from the accessibility regulations.

Some third-party content may be outside the school's control. Where possible, we will choose accessible services and provide alternative ways of accessing important information.

What we are doing to improve accessibility

We are committed to improving the accessibility of our website.

We will:

- consider accessibility when adding or updating website content;
- use clear headings and meaningful link text;
- add appropriate descriptions to informative images;
- consider accessibility when producing new documents;
- remove or replace inaccessible documents where appropriate;
- provide information in alternative formats on request;
- review the website regularly for accessibility issues; and
- work with our website provider where technical accessibility issues are identified.

Accessibility will form part of our ongoing website compliance review.
