Each day, another window design will be assembled and illuminated around the village. On the 24th, all of the windows will be on display. Change to term dates and KS2 SATS - May 2023

Ministers have considered the situation carefully and have decided that KS2 tests will take place in the same week with tests following the usual order but each taking place one day later than originally planned. As such, the new schedule will start on Tuesday 9th May – Friday 12th May 2023.
