#### **Headteacher Awards**

#### **Egyptian Workshop**

#### Reading, Tables and Spellings

We would like to remind families of the importance of finding a small amount of time every day to share/listen to your child read, practice times tables and number bonds together and to review your child's spellings. Evidence shows that learning is more successful with a short, daily revisit rather than a longer session once a week or more infrequently.

#### **Updated Guidance from Suffolk County Council**

'If there is a positive case within a household, and siblings are identified as close contacts, please could parents and carers notify any other educational settings that the siblings attend. This allows those settings to be alerted to the potential of infection within their own setting.'

#### **School Uniform**

We understand that it may have been difficult to purchase school uniform items during lockdown but could we please ask families to check their children's school uniform provision to ensure that plimsolls, trainers, school shoes, wellington boots, etc still fit comfortably, and that skirts are of an appropriate length and that all items are labelled. Most items are in stock and a uniform order form is available from the school website or the school office.

#### **Social Distancing**

We would ask that, where possible, only one adult per family group brings the children to school each morning and after school to minimise the number of adults outside the school. We would ask you to remember to observe social distancing whilst waiting for collection and to stagger your walks along the slip road to ensure that we are all following safe protocols.
