### 8<sup>th</sup> April – End of term church service

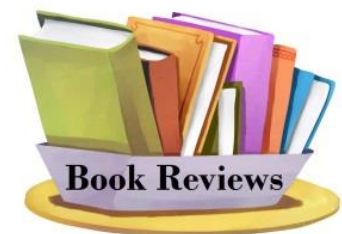
