Remote Learning

Full School Reopening

We are delighted to be able to welcome all children back to school on Monday 8th March. Our existing Covid-19 prevention measures will still be in place and the Risk Assessment is available on our website. Current guidance indicates that best practice would be for one adult only to accompany children to school to minimise congestion. School access will be available from 8.30 am and children should enter using their respective doorway entrances.

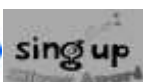
