Saturn Class Visit to the Fitzwilliam Museum, Cambridge – 6th February

Amelia and Myla write - Yesterday we went to the Fitzwilliam Museum in Cambridge. We went to learn about the Ancient Greeks. While we were there we saw sculptures made of marble, orange and black pots and beautiful jewellery. We examined a sarcophagus to learn about mythical creatures and the gods of Ancient Greece. Some of the gods we saw were Zeus, Pan and Poseidon. We also saw a statue of the goddess Athene who is the goddess of war and intelligence.

At the museum we walked up a grand marble staircase covered in dazzling, gold which was stunning. After lunch, we visited the painting gallery. Free School Meal status entitles your child to a paid lunch every day but also means they are then eligible to benefit from pupil premium funding which the school can spend to benefit the individual child's learning and development. Further details about how we spend Pupil Premium are published on the school website but frequently include individual tuition, support/extension programmes and can be used to cover the cost of external visits.

Pupil Progress

As a reminder, we are changing the way we share information with families about their child's learning and progress in the Spring Term. Each year group has been invited to attend a workshop led by the class teacher. At the end of the workshop written feedback for your child will be available along with their books. A letter has been sent home and dates are also detailed below.

Mobile Phone Use

As you may be aware there has been media coverage this week about the impact of mobile phones in children's rooms at night. As part of our pastoral care and whole child emphasis, we are concerned that some children are communicating with each other using their phones and tablets after they have gone to bed. We would strongly encourage families to ensure they have the appropriate settings on their devices and internet parental controls are in place as, on occasion, upsets sent by social media have impacted on the school learning day. We will be sending a parent information sheet as part of our Safer Internet Day planned for 11th February 2020, but do please contact the school if you would like further advice or guidance.

Parking

With so many parents bringing pupils to school by car we wish to emphasise the safe parking message to everyone. The Five Bells car park is available to park in on the side nearest the village green. The side nearest the pub is private, and we ask you to respect this. Parking beyond the Church is possible but is often difficult, so the village is the best option. Thank you for your cooperation in this. Please respect the

need for children's visibility when crossing the road by not parking on the yellow lines under any circumstances. This supports the school when children are visiting the local area and also helps children who are walking home independently to be safe when crossing the road.
