A reminder that during October we will be moving to an online payment service called **+Pay** on **ParentMail** which allows families to pay for school meals and visits quickly and easily on smartphones, tablets or computers. Once the system is live, you will receive an email from ParentMail using the email account already held on school records.

#### **Car Parking**

Can we please remind all families who drive to school to be mindful and respectful of the need for safe parking. It is not acceptable to park on the yellow lines at school pick up and drop off times, or at any time on double yellow lines. This is particularly important by the Church as parked cars impede visibility and make walking and crossing the road more dangerous. For your information, we are advised that the parking bays nearest the village green in the Five Bells car park are public parking, and the side nearest the pub is for patrons only. We would ask you not to double park in the Five Bells car park as this impedes people's ability to leave and so get to work on time. We are sure that everyone will agree the safety of pedestrians is our utmost priority.
