Royal Shakespeare Associate School Workshop

Ellie writes : The RSC workshop is held by a professional person from this company who comes to different schools in England to help us feel more confident about acting and what it is all about.

Firstly we did some exercises outside with Ollie, the person who came, that help you to rely on and build trust with others, and how we can make acting exciting for others to watch and feel confident on stage. We also did some acting on Scene 111 – it's the scene we are doing at the theatre. Theatre Tickets

Suncream, hats and water bottles

As we are currently enjoying unseasonal warm weather, please ensure that your child is equipped for the day ahead. Where possible, we would prefer that children have their sun cream applied at home using one of the longer lasting creams that only need one daily application. If it is essential for your child to bring sun cream in to school, they must be able to self-administer this and it should be in a clearly named bottle. We would encourage children to bring a hat to school to wear outside both at playtime and as part of outdoor learning. Children are able to refill their water bottles during the school day as every classroom is

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equipped with drinking water. Please do ensure your child has their water bottle with them each morning and evening and remember that cups are not available at lunchtime as part of the kitchen's Covid-19 measures.
