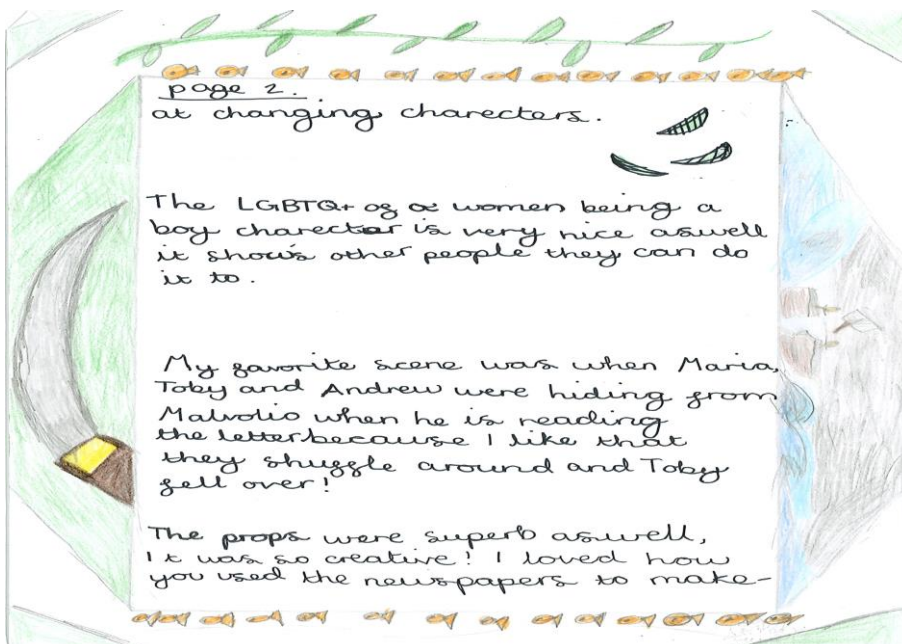
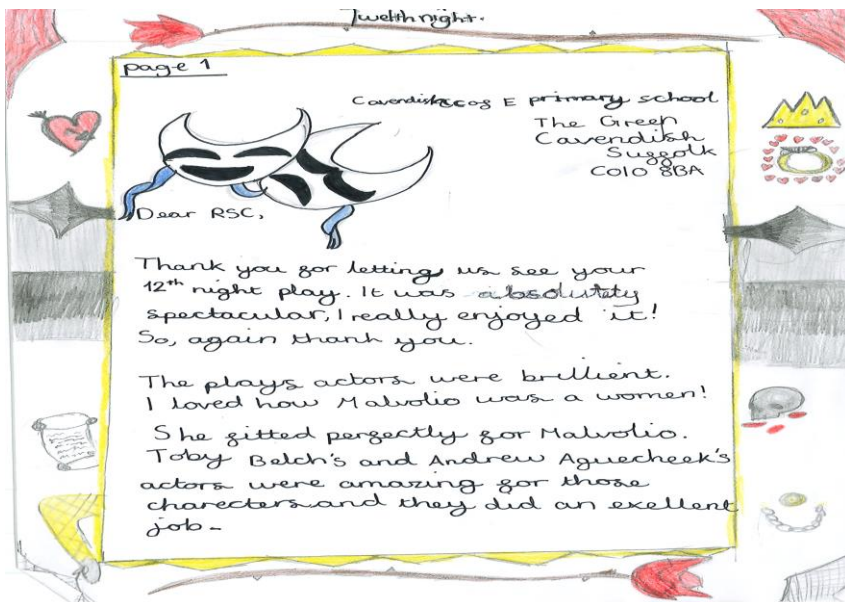
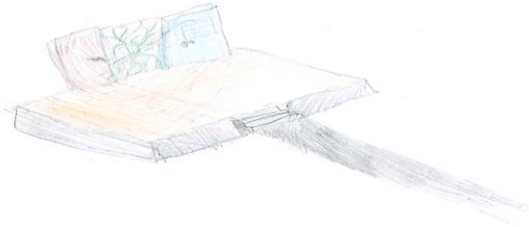
Dear RSC,

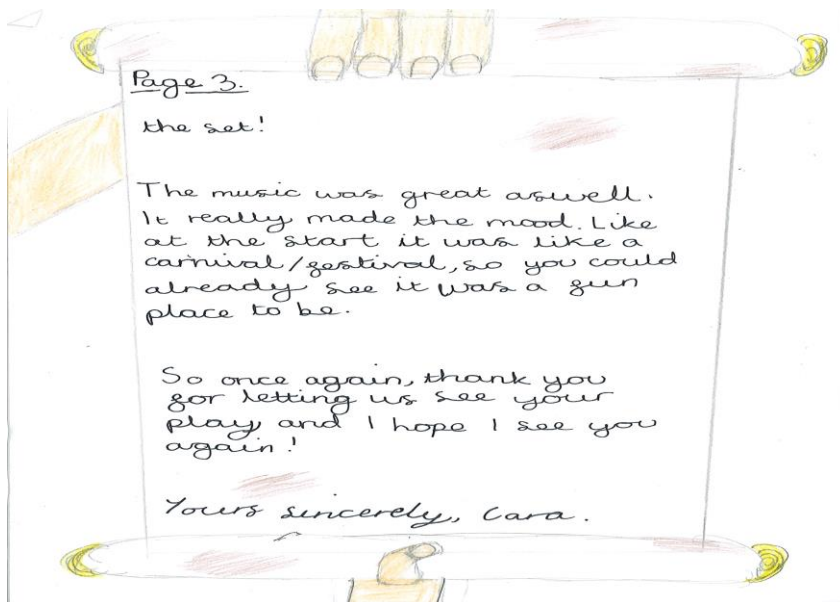
