- On Tuesday we practiced with Josh, he was good at dancing, he came from Don Rae academy, We danced to lots of popular song and the dance moves were really cool. We learnt body ripples and the leg criss cross. It was great to learn.
- We learnt dance moves with a professional dancer, no spoilers for the dance festival but a clue is in the music... respectable, thriller, never gonna give you up!!
- I enjoyed the galloping and learning moves to the music, I can not wait to show the parents.
- Some of us have a character part in the dance routine, this was great fun and I am so excited for dance festival
- I really enjoyed practicing our dance for the festival and learning the new dance moves

#### **Year 6 Crucial Crew visit**

We were delighted to be able to attend Crucial Crew Workshop this year with our year 6 children. They were able to take part in various activities such as making a 999 call, learning to stay safe, understanding bullying and where to get help and preparing for secondary school. These are some of the comments from the year 6 children that attended.

- One of the activities was water safety, we did this by one by laying on the floor, pretending to be stuck in water and shouting for help. The other person then got the life ring and threw it into the water and tugged us to safety.
- We learnt about germs and how washing our hands helps keeping us safe, by washing our hands in a sensible way it helps stop the spread of germs. This helped us understand the importance of hand washing.
- We learnt how to make a 999 call, we had to tell the police, ambulance or fire service where we lived, what street and the support we needed. It was serious activity but was fun too.
- We learnt how to stay safe, one subject was bullying. Older children from TGS came and performed a play about bullying and who to call when you are being bullied.
- We learnt how to perform CPR, we were taught by an ambulance driver. We had to put our hand in a fist and our other hand over that fist. Normally CPR involved mouth to mouth but at the moment we don't do that, just chest compressions.
