Extreme weather

Please be advised that we are following NHS guidance about extreme weather. This means that children are taking their breaks in shaded areas with quiet activities such as lego, board games, drawing and reading. The school is continuing in its open ventilation policy and this ensures as much through breeze as possible. Some classes are supplemented with fans. Classroom activities are being adapted and children are reminded to take frequent drinks, and wear their sunhats/ apply suncream as required. Fewer lights and electrical equipment is on to help maintain temperatures. Children may wear PE kits to school next week. PE and forest school will be taught inside where necessary. Should there be any change to this parents will be informed.

Back to School - September 2022 Autumn Term

Term starts for the children on Monday 5th September. We will be continuing with PE for each class on the same day and children should continue to wear the PE kit into school.

A key change for September is the length of the school day. New government legislation requires primary school children to attend for 32.5hrs per week as a national minimum. In order to meet this requirement we are moving the start of the school day to 8.45am for registration. Children who arrive after this time will be marked at late. The format of the school day will be as follows:

8.30 am – front gate open for wake and shake

8.40 am – main gate open

8.45am - Class registration and start of the school day

12noon – Lunch

3.15pm - End of school day

When clubs are running these end at 4pm and after school tuition ends 4.15pm
