Science

This half term in Science, Robins class will be learning about Plants.

We will find out what plants need to grow, explore bulbs and seeds, plan investigations, and plant our own bulbs and seeds.

PSHE

Robins will learn to recognise hazards, assess and manage risks, and develop safety skills for increasing independence. Building confidence in handling risks supports long-term well-being and resilience.

History

Big question: What is a monarch?

Robins class will understand the role of monarchs, the coronation ceremony, and how William the Conqueror became king. They will explore changes to castles and monarchy over time, making comparisons between the past and today.

Geography

Big Question: What is it like to live in Shanghai?

This half term in Geography, Robins class will identify and describe human and physical features locally and globally. They will use maps, aerial photographs, and atlases to locate places and features, and compare Shanghai to their own locality.

Writing and Reading

This half term, Robins class will be learning to write personal recounts.

They will practise using the first person, past tense, and chronological order, adding detail with adjectives, adverbs, and expanded noun phrases. We will focus on accurate punctuation and editing skills.

In reading, we will explore The Quangle Wangle's Hat by Edward Lear.

Children will summarise, retrieve information, learn about changing word meanings, and practise fluent, expressive reading.

Robin class will be learning about Judaism

PE

Robin class will be working on a group dance routine for the upcoming dance festival. They'll also develop their tennis skills through weekly sessions with a specialist coach involving Rackets, Bats and Balls.

Maths

This half term, Robins class will be recognising, counting, and comparing amounts of money, before moving on to calculating totals and finding change. Following this, we will begin exploring fractions. The children will learn to identify parts and wholes, understand the difference between equal and unequal parts, and recognise and find halves and quarters.
