Jupiter: *This week we have explored command sentences and we used imperative verbs. "Bring me a chocolate cake!" said Laurence.*

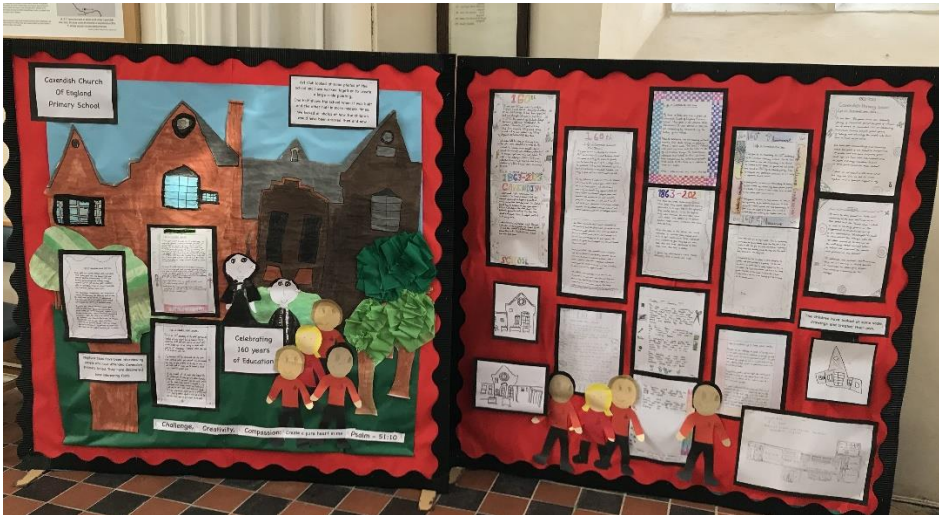
