Covid-19

The school continues to follow its Risk Assessment for managing Covid-19 safety and control measures. We work alongside Public Health Suffolk, Public Health England and Suffolk County Council. Covid-19 Isolation

We have been asked to clarify the following:

Should a family member display symptoms of Covid-19 or be required to take a PCR test, the guidance from www.gov.uk applies. "Your isolation period starts immediately from when your symptoms started, or,

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if you do not have any symptoms from the day your test was taken. Your isolation period includes the day your symptoms started (or the day your test was taken if you do not have symptoms), and the next 10 full days".
